THE CITY & VENUE



Old and new, typical and cosmopolitan, the City of Buenos Aires is one of the most dynamic economies in the region. With a population of three million, Buenos Aires is one of the cultural capitals of South America. The city's infrastructure, its history and culture, and an architecture that combines the past with Avant-guard designs, are an invitation to the millions of tourists that arrive all year round.

Home of great poets, painters, musicians, and dancers, and with a rich history that is very much alive in the urban memory, the rhythm of culture is restless in a metropolis that is always open to new trends. Known around the world as the capital of tango, its music and dance invades the scene, whether at the most sophisticated tango dance halls or the most popular neighborhood milonga. Its performing arts rank among the world's best, making it the fourth most important city in the world of theater. Traditional and modern museums are famous, and the indie scene -off theater productions, art cinema, non-mainstream music and design- is thriving.

In Buenos Aires you can enjoy both typical Argentine food and exquisite international cuisine. With over 3,500 restaurants, large variety is what characterizes the food industry in the city, from ethnic food and gourmet restaurants, to international fast-food chains and take-out bars. However, the star is still the classic parrilla, or Argentine-style barbecue.

Buenos Aires is an accessible city. It is connected to the world by two international airports. With 775 international flights a week from 47 cities of different continents, it is easy to find the way to be there.

The City offers a large range of possibilities to move freely and ecofriendly: you can choose between sub-way, bus, train, but also renting the bicycles and electric inline scooters of the City



PLACE OF THE CONGRESS

The “La Rural” fairground annually receives more than 300 events and almost 4 million visitors. It has an area of more than 12 hectares for exhibitions, fairs and congresses, with a privileged location in the heart of Palermo, emblematic neighborhood of Buenos Aires city.

This fairground is recognized nationally and internationally thanks to its large dimensions of spaces and versatility, with a high level of excellence. It combines tradition and avant-garde, embodied in a strong vocation for service and a state-of-the-art infrastructure.

Composed of seven pavilions, Central and Convention Center, offers a Main Auditorium (3.000 seats), 9 conference rooms (between 200 and 800 seats), 4 meetings rooms (20 seats), registration building and a place for exhibition, posters and lunch of 90,000 m².

In 2011 this place was used for the organization of the XXII Latin-American Poultry Congress (3.000 registrations) and also there was a need of a main auditorium, 6 different conference rooms, a registration building, space for an exhibition of 250 stands, a coffee-break and lunch area for 4.000 people.



Accommodation

Buenos Aires is one of the cities with the largest options of lodging in Latin America. From big hotels (Sheraton, Amerian, Accor, Four Seasons, Hyatt) to small charming Boutique Hotels, Bed & Breakfast, Home Staying, Hostels and temporary rental.

Not too long ago all the accommodation places in Buenos Aires here located downtown and few ones in Recoleta. Today it is possible to find first class possibilities in Palermo, Villa Crespo, San Telmo, Almagro, North Zone (San Isidro, Tigre, Pilar) and even some kilometers far away from the Capital City, which gave to the visitors a range of choices.

Buenos Aires has 73,000 rooms, from a comfortable 2-star hotel (10 USD/night) to the luxury five-star hotel (200 USD/night), and more than 6,000 in close proximity of the Conference Center or with easy connection. In the event that the WPSA confirms the Congress, there will be negotiated special and closed rates and conditions for the WPC.

Visas

Depending on the nationality of the delegates and the duration of their stay in Argentina, it may be necessary for them to obtain a visa before leaving. In this case, they should apply to the Argentine consulate in their country.

ORGANIZATION

Presentation of the local branch of the WPSA

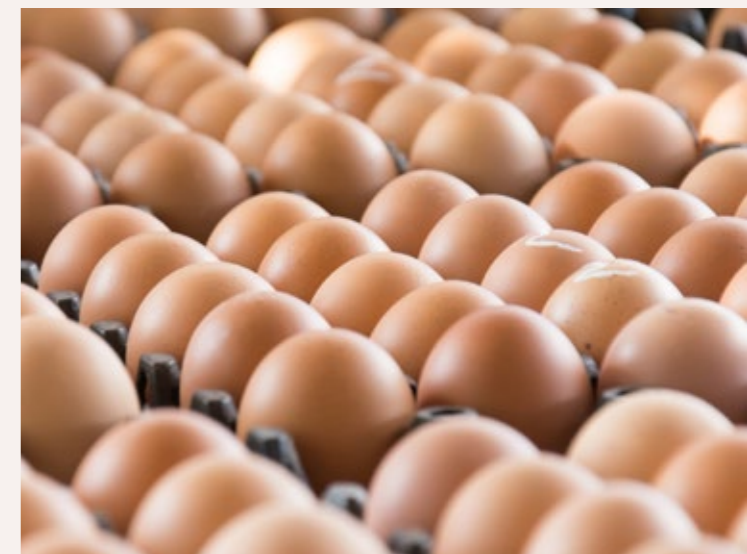
The WPSA Argentina has more than 100 members and its board is a good sample of the composition: members from higher education and research institutions, technicians and professionals in the poultry sector. The branch is regularly organizing poultry meetings in Argentina in partnership with other associations, such as others of poultry technicians (AMEVEA & GTA) and the ones of poultry producers and processors (CAPIA & CEPA). These associations are supporting the initiative of WPSA Argentina as shown by their support letters. The branch benefits from the experience in organizing the XXII Latin-American Poultry Congress by CAPIA & CEPA in 2011, because the chairperson and other members of the Scientific Committee were also members of the WPSA Argentina board.

Previous expertise in organizing meetings

The WPSA Argentina was partner of the Entre Rios Veterinarian Association of Poultry Specialists (AMEVEA) in the organization of the International Poultry Seminars of 2008, 2010 and 2013. About 400 people attended the events. Furthermore, the organization of the scientific programme of the XXII Latin-American Poultry Congress (Buenos Aires city, 2011), was done by the Scientific Committee with WPSA members for more than 3,000 people attending the conferences. In addition, last year the branch was partner of CAPIA in the organization of the International Seminar on Poultry Production and of GTA in the organization of its Annual Technical Seminar.

Overall Poultry Production

Argentina is an important producer of broiler meat and eggs ranking 9th and 8th worldwide, respectively. Since 2003, broiler production has more than quadrupled, and exports have exceeded imports, representing 10-16% of the total national production. For eggs both production and consumption have doubled since 2001. The 2019 broiler meat per capita consumption is forecast in 43.1 kg and egg consumption in 274 units per person.



Involvement of the national organizations

Several associations and institutions support the organization of the WPC 2024 in Buenos Aires. The three associations of poultry technicians (AMEVEA, GTA & GEA), the two national associations of poultry producers and processors (CAPIA & CEPA), the two universities more involved in poultry production & health research (UNLu & UNLP), the two universities of the city with poultry faculty (UBA & UCA), the two centers of the National Institute of Agricultural Technology (INTA) more involved in poultry research, the area of the National Agriculture Ministry for animal livestock, the National Tourism Secretariat and the Buenos Aires Tourist Board of the Buenos Aires City Government.

The suppliers of the poultry industry also support the bid, because the chambers of the companies of animal nutrition (CAENA) and veterinarian products (CLAMEVET & CAPROVE) do. Nevertheless, not only national organizations are supporting Buenos Aires WPC 2024. **The Latin-American Poultry Association (ALA) also supports the bid of Buenos Aires City.**

Involvement of the national branch of WPSA

WPSA Argentina is leading the project to organize the WPC in Buenos Aires. In fact, the chairperson of the Organizing Committee would be Prof. Julian Melo, Honorary President of the branch and President during 10 years. Moreover, the current President of the branch,

Dr. Dante Bueno also would be a member of the Organizing Committee and the current Secretary, Dr. Bernardo Iglesias, would be the chairperson of the Scientific Committee.

Responsibility for administrative affairs

The Organizing Committee, the Buenos Aires Convention Bureau and MBG & EVENTS will work together as a team to get an efficient management and successful WPC. MBG & EVENTS is one of the most important event organizing companies in Argentina and has broad experience in poultry events (every two years organizes the poultry producer's trade show and was involved in the 2011 Latin-American Poultry Congress).





Organizing Committee

The organizing committee shall be composed by researchers, academicians and members of technician's organizations, but also by people from poultry producers associations, public institutions and private companies. The aim of combining different professional profiles is to get a good organizational level, but also to attract private sponsorship in order to get extra revenue for an even better Congress organization. 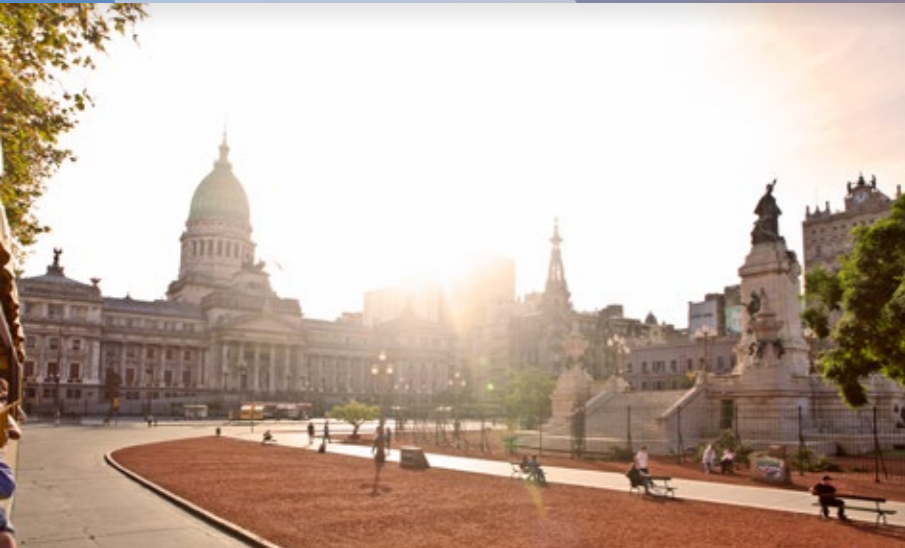

Technical visits

Technical visits are planned for Friday 30th August. The Organizing Committee will offer 4/5 options. These visits will allow the participants to learn about the poultry production in Argentina.

Youth and student programme

The goal of this programme is to give the students possibility to attend the World's Poultry Congress 2024 in Buenos Aires, Argentina, and to present their papers. The registration fees will be cheaper than usually and will include a free workshop of necropsy and microbiology interpretation, and visits to cultural and natural sites. Applicants must be a student (undergraduate, graduate, master or PhD student). Maximum age of the applicant should be 35 at the time of application. Applicants must submit an abstract for an oral or poster presentations and be the first author.

Social programme

Open Ceremony & Get Together Party cocktail (Monday 26th August) with entertainment surprises are included in the registration fees.

Accompanying persons programme

Other half-day activities not included in the registration fee will be offered to the accompanying persons.

Old & new downtown: It starts in the heart of downtown Buenos Aires, a few meters from the Plaza de Mayo. On the way, you will be able to see landmark buildings, historic and cultural sites and unique neighborhoods. Each stop opens up a new world, maybe to the multicolored neighborhood of La Boca, to the aristocratic past of Avenida Alvear or the traditions of San Telmo neighborhood.

Green Buenos Aires: It begins at the Malba, one of the most important art museums of the city of Buenos Aires. The route explores some of the parks and green areas in Buenos Aires, like Palermo Woods, and some of the most important sites related to Argentine sports: the Campo Argentino de Polo stadium or the River Plate football stadium, known as "El Monumental".

Buenos Aires offers unique experiences: private guided tours, shopping experiences, traditional and delicious tastings, sunset sailing, bike tours and all that you can imagine.




